

When I made the seemingly crazy decision to move from Australia to Chicago, they didn't dissuade me as I thought they would. There must have been something in my eyes or in my voice as I spoke with them that told them that one, I was serious, and two, that this is the right thing for me.

And it has been. I am finally truly, contentedly happy and have found my place in the world. Of course, there were ups and downs too, and times when I questioned my decision, but like all the artists in the StarCentral family, it is my family and my friends (and my faith) that got me through it. Fame isn't Everything


I was surrounded by fame and fortune Yet I HATED my Life

It was not and we were all getting drunk fast. It was a Sunday session at 'The Prince of Wales', St Kilda Beach. I'm not too sure what we were celebrating that day but whatever it was, it was perfect for a big announcement being that everyone was there from our little group of friends.

With five years of acting under his belt and very little work, this would be the day that would change my roommate & best friend, Paul O'Brien's life forever. He had the biggest 'call back' audition of his acting career, to play the new town cop, Jack Holden on popular TV soap, 'Home & Away.'

This would be an image I will never forget. As I was chatting to good friend, Geoffrey Barefoot about 'God knows what', I could see Paul standing at the door with the biggest smile on his face. Geoffrey's voice faded along with the pub music and drunken chatter. I knew exactly what Paul was about to announce, and away he went. "I just scored a 3-year deal on Home and Away!" he yelled at the top of his lungs. It was an amazing feeling for all who were in that bar at that one moment. A massive cheer and applause erupted from 'The Prince Of Wales' and we celebrated until early the next morning. Of course, Paul went missing for a good 2 hours ringing all his close friends and family. It was a very messy but memorable moment that I'll never forget but, who would have thought that it would also change my life forever as well.





Paul had a week to get packing and head for Sydney to play Jack Holden. It was a surreal and extremely sad experience for myself, and of course his girlfriend at the time, Lia. The taxi was waiting and it was time for that emotional hug good bye, but at the same time it was very exciting for all of us, especially Paul. It was hard to watch Paul and Lia hug for what would be the last time. At the time Paul held himself together well, but years later he confessed that he shed a little tear in the cab on the way to the airport.

Six months had gone by and I was struggling without my side kick, Paul O'Brien being around. And I feel he felt the same way, because he invited me up for the weekend to propose something to me. I couldn't believe the lifestyle he was living. It was insane, having a driver take him everywhere, the city view from his apartment, the parties, the girls, the money, people noticing him on the street, the lifestyle was crazy and I wanted it.

That weekend, Paul told me he was buying an apartment in the Manly area and wanted me to move in and enjoy the girls, the parties...the real bachelor lifestyle with him. As amazing as this sounded, there was a catch - I would be moving into his garage which was 2 levels away from the apartment. Yes. that's correct, two levels from the bathroom, But, how could one resist such an offer? I thought at the time that this would be great for me as an actor living with a celebrity. The people I'd meet and the opportunities would be endless. Who knows, maybe he could get me a gig on 'Home and Away'? Later on in life I would come to realise I would be wrong, and that success comes from working hard on your craft, not from being best mates with a well-known actor on a well-known soap.

A year went by and I was struggling as an actor more than ever. I had landed 2 small guest roles, 'Home & Away' and 'Blue Water High and a Weet-Bix TV commercial. My grand plan wasn't working and nor was I. It was a bit of a salt rubbed over the wound having your best mate living your dream right in front of you.

Paul was dominating the industry. Not only was he playing the most popular character on the most popular TV series in Australia at the time, he was invited to be a contestant on the new singing show, 'It Takes Two'. From shopping centre appearances, hottest man on TV for the year, Cleo Bachelor runner up, to red carpet film premieres, Paul was getting stronger and I

was getting jealous. He even made an appearance singing at 'The Carols In The Domain' a week before Christmas Day 2006. It was the day I met Alexis Evans. Paul ended up having to go on stage with Alexis' sister Indiana to sing the closing number. Alexis and I came to realise we had a lot in common - that we were surrounded by fame and it was eating us up. Alexis' sister Indiana was also on the show, 'Home & Away' and was also extremely popular.

Alexis and I started dating, which was good for me because it gave me a distraction from all Paul's fame and success, But being that Alexis still lived at home with Indiana & her family made things even worse for me. Now I was getting Indiana Evans' and Paul O'Brien's fame rubbed in my face everywhere I went, and to top it off, Indiana started dating the extremely popular new-kid-on-the-block, Lincoln Lewis, It was everywhere I went and it was eating me up. I was starting to realise having a famous best friend wasn't all it was was cut out to be, although, I did get very good at taking photos for all of Paul's 'Home and Away' fans. Was I really 'that guy' holding onto the coat tails of his best mate?

Three years went by and yes, I was having the time of my life, but I wasn't landing any roles and was surrounded by fame and fortune. I had to get away from it all and get my own ball rolling. Paul's contract came to an end and was now ready to take on Hollywood. Things didn't really work out with Alexis, so I decided to fly back to Melbourne.

It was time to do things 'My Way'. The very first day I arrived back in Melbourne, I came to realise I didn't really know any of the up-and-coming local actors. So I posted an online blog inviting local actors to come to meet at my place for an "Actors get together" where we would look over

scripts, put up scenes, anything acting. Every Tuesday night I would get 20-30 passionate actors come to my place and do their thing. It was an amazing group, and I created it. For the first time in my life, I felt I was doing things my way, not following in the footsteps of someone else's dream. And, you guessed it, I started booking some amazing acting jobs.

So many talented actors were attending my 'Actors get together', that it was creating a very fast growing group of friends all with the same passion. Paul O'Brien even started teaching at the 'Actors get togethers'. One of them went on to play 'Spartacus' in the epic television series. One of the regular 'Actors get together' attendee's, James Mason was so talented I had to introduce him to my agent at the time, Alison Telford. Alison, also saw his unique talent and signed him in a heartbeat. After scoring a movie together, "The Legend of Billy Sing", now known as, "The Stolen" James and I became so close, we decided to rent out a house together. Then came his big 'Neighbours' contract. But, things were a little different this time round. Being that I was doing my own thing. I had no time to get jealous of his acting success.

When I came back to Melbourne in 2010 I've landed TV roles such as being a co-host for Foxtel's 'Planet Unearth', the series lead to 'The Boys Place' and multiple TV commercials. I've been involved in at least 10 feature films and not to mention I've booked over 200 leading roles in Short films, Presenting gigs and corporate video's.



A host of online networking initiatives have sprung up within the entertainment industry. Undoubtedly, the web provides an excellent platform for any artist – but the caveat is that one must be selective and savvy. Knowing where to go online is crucial, and like with any source of information on the net, "sifting" is required to separate the wheat from the chaff, the genuine from the genuinely suspect.

Think of this article as an insider's guide: here are my top five online networking ventures – debunked.

1. StarCentral Magazine

Well, you are obviously reading this so StarCentral Magazine must have piqued your interest. And for good reason! StarCentral promotes local talents from around the world and supports artists on a grass roots level. You can access handy industry tips plus scintillating editorial – all in the one place. Visit the contact page if you are interested in being featured as an artist.

2 Starnow

Are you on Star Now? Chances are you have come across the site - pretty much anyone involved in the entertainment industry appears to be using it. Just in case you aren't familiar here are the specs - a basic profile is free and there is a small subscription fee to use the full service of the website. Audition and castings are updated every day.

Anyone can list an audition or job (so be mindful of amateurs) but a lot of well known companies/enterprises do use Star Now to advertise e.g. X Factor, Big Brother, Bras N Things, Chiko... the list goes on. You can refine your specification, become part of the talent directory, and can receive email alerts. There is also a Star Now phone app.

The site is great for finding promotional work and paid work can be found – it is just a matter of sourcing it out. Always check the website of the company advertising. You create a profile for yourself and this is a handy link to flick to potential employers.

3. Model Mayhem

Who out there is an "MMer"? If you haven't a clue what I am talking about then you must not have stumbled upon the self professed "#1 portfolio website for professional models and photographers". Model Mayhem (MM) is a website that allows you to create a portfolio, search castings and participate in forums.

An online community, MM has its codes of behaviour so make sure you read up on these. You'll notice it's big on etiquette. You will also undoubtedly notice it's also quite big on nudity. You can toggle this on or off for safe viewing. A fair share of scams do come through MM – there is information contained on the site that may assist you to detect and avoid these. Look for professional and quality work before agreeing to meet with any photographer and (as discussed previously) always bring a chaperone.

4 Facebook groups

Facebook groups that network artists are burgeoning. There are a million and one initiatives out there, plus all the usual promotion groups for those who need votes for various competitions. I am aware of some Queensland based groups that may be of use – "SEQ Casting" and "Gold Coast and Brisbane Photographers and Models" for actors and models respectively. "Super Models Australia" and "Model Comps – Gold Coast – Brisbane" are groups that are useful for those who wish to enter competitions and pageants.

5 Artist / band / public figure Facebook page

Creating a public figure page on Facebook is a nice way to showcase your work and provide an easily accessible portfolio. You can then direct interest to this page via a link. You can display your biggest achievements as well as smaller victories.

Remember, keeping at the forefront of your online audience's minds and keeping constantly on top of opportunities is the ticket to web success.


2 Matt Penson





They say that eyes are the window to the soul. If it's sexy appeal that you wish to exude then there's nothing quite like the classic cat's eye. However, Angelina Jolie's makeup staple demands a certain technique (to keep the lines clean and not an inky mess).

The cat's eye uses liquid eyeliner to achieve a bold, sultry, and yet, sophisticated look. I'm often asked how I get it right day after day - I've got it down to an application that takes mere seconds. Follow my easy tips and you'll soon be staring down the competition.

Preliminaries:

- Go shopping for an eyelid primer.
 Eyelid primer will create a clean line not a watery one.
- •Look for a "nib tip" when you are first buying liquid eyeliner. Just like a pen, this applicator type is firm and creates a steady line. This is the best place to start when you are first using liquid eyeliner. You can move on to a "brush tip" when you become steadier. In the end, it is all what your hand gets used to but in my experience a nib tip is the place to start.
- Trial liquid eyeliners on your hand.
 Look for a bold, dense line not a watery one.
- Invest in a good eye make-up remover. If you have sensitive skin look for gentle formulae as the under-eye area is very delicate.

Application:

- Dab a small amount of your eyelid primer (what fits on a cotton tip) on each eye and smooth over the eyelid evenly.
- Try placing your elbow on your basin when you go to start using your liquid

eyeliner. This will create steadiness and added dexterity. Shut one eye and draw a line as close as possible to the lash line to the outer corner. Leave your eyelid shut for a few seconds to dry. Stop at the end of the eyelid and repeat on the other eye.

•Now you can add your cat's eye "wing". This is the element that makes things that little bit sexier, yet, still sophisticated. Apply to one eye at a time (and keeping your eyelid shut and letting dry afterward) extend your line for the outer corners of the eyelids with a curve that flicks upward and outward.


Finishing touches:

- You can fix any mistakes with eye makeup remover. Dip a cotton tip in the solution and use as an eraser should a mishap occur.
- Finish with a volumising mascara to add extra impact to your look and to balance the boldness of your liquid eyeliner.
- Fill in brows with your appropriate shade (fair, medium or dark) of eyebrow pencil or powder.
- Add a touch of highlighter to your brow bones to add that final, sublimely sexy touch. Simply dab on the product just underneath the eye brow and blend. Luminous magic!

3. The Woman Convinced She Was Usher's Wife



2 Lovely Osarobo



3 John K-Ay



MOST FASCINATING PERSON OF THE MONTH POPE FRANCIS

As I pen this article the world's 1.2 billion Catholics are celebrating the announcement of its new leader; the recently elected Cardinal Jorge Mario Bergoglio of Argentina, now to be known around the world as Pope Francis, Given the alobal nature of the Papacy's influence, it comes as no surprise that almost everyone around me - both physical and virtual has an opinion about what this will mean for the future. News websites, Facebook feeds and Twitter rolls have been ablaze with discussion: what is this guy like, where is he from, why is he so old, and (the auestion that amuses me the most) is he a liberal or conservative Catholic? (The answer to the final question is that he is neither; he is simply Catholic).

Shortly after he greeted the freezing crowd at St Peter's Square, I learned the following facts: Pope Francis lived a surprisingly humble life whilst serving as



Cardinal in Buenos Aires. He chose to live in a simple apartment, he cooked his own meals and rode the bus to work (after the Conclave he even rejected the use of the papal limousine and caught the minibus back to his hotel with the rest of the cardinals). Cardinal Timothy Dolan from New York reported that when Pope Francis was elected,

Vatican officials and staffers came forward to meet him but he politely refused, telling them, "Not now. The people are waiting". Then he went to the balcony.

When I watched his first address the first thing I noticed was that Pope Francis looked nervous. I smiled to myself, thinking how overwhelming it must be to front up to such a large, expectant crowd and the world's media as The New Pope, when just a few weeks ago he was probably preparing dinner in his simple Argentinian kitchen. I can just imagine him boiling a pot of rice for dinner. Suddenly this old man's job description was a whole lot longer - and through no campaigning on his part. Unlike politicians who run for office, asking for our vote and so putting themselves forward for scrutinity, this man's credentials, mistakes and theological values are now being judged and thanks to the internet and social media by millions of people who have limited or no understanding of Catholicism. No wonder it took him a few moments before he could smile at the camera.

Yet despite his nervousness, I do believe he had a stellar first performance on the global stage. Bowing low before the crowd, he abandoned formalities and greeted everyone with a friendly 'Good evening'. He acknowledged and asked everyone to pray for his predecessor Bishop Emeritus Benedict XVI. Then he asked the world a favour; to first say a prayer for him as the new Bishop of Rome. This upfront admission that the office of Pope was greater than he, and that as a leader he needed both God's help and ours, was a powerful gesture of humility. I dare say that his simple request moved quite a few hearts - it certainly surprised me and won me over.

He also surprised people by calling a

mass media conference only days after his election.

There he acknowledged how essential mass media are - more so now than ever before. Perhaps this is a Pope who understands the digital age. While he wouldn't have the desire or power to change any of the Catholic doctrine that has been discussed without abandon on social media (yes, this includes the ordination of female priests or the definition of same-sex unions as 'marriage'), his opportunity to make waves shouldn't be underestimated. His less formal mannerisms and eagerness to engage media indicate a desire for more transparency and trust between the Church and the public. His fervent love for the poor and adoption of the name Francis (after St Francis of Assisi) has also created an opportunity for the Catholic Church to highlight and increase its contribution to areas of social justice and provision of welfare.

So even though it's still early days I have high hopes for this guy. I don't have a catalogue of his accomplishments or a running sheet of his stance on specific social issues, but at this stage I don't want them either. All I'd like to do at this moment is acknowledge that this man, in all his nervousness, shyness and old age is someone who has been handed a rather big boat to steer. And to borrow the words a dear friend of mine posted on Facebook: he is man who's trying to do his best - not for his glory but for God's. Not for his own salvation, but for ours. Irrespective of our opinions on them, or our religious views, he deserves our respect, and most definitely our prayers.
